



ARPITA DATTA

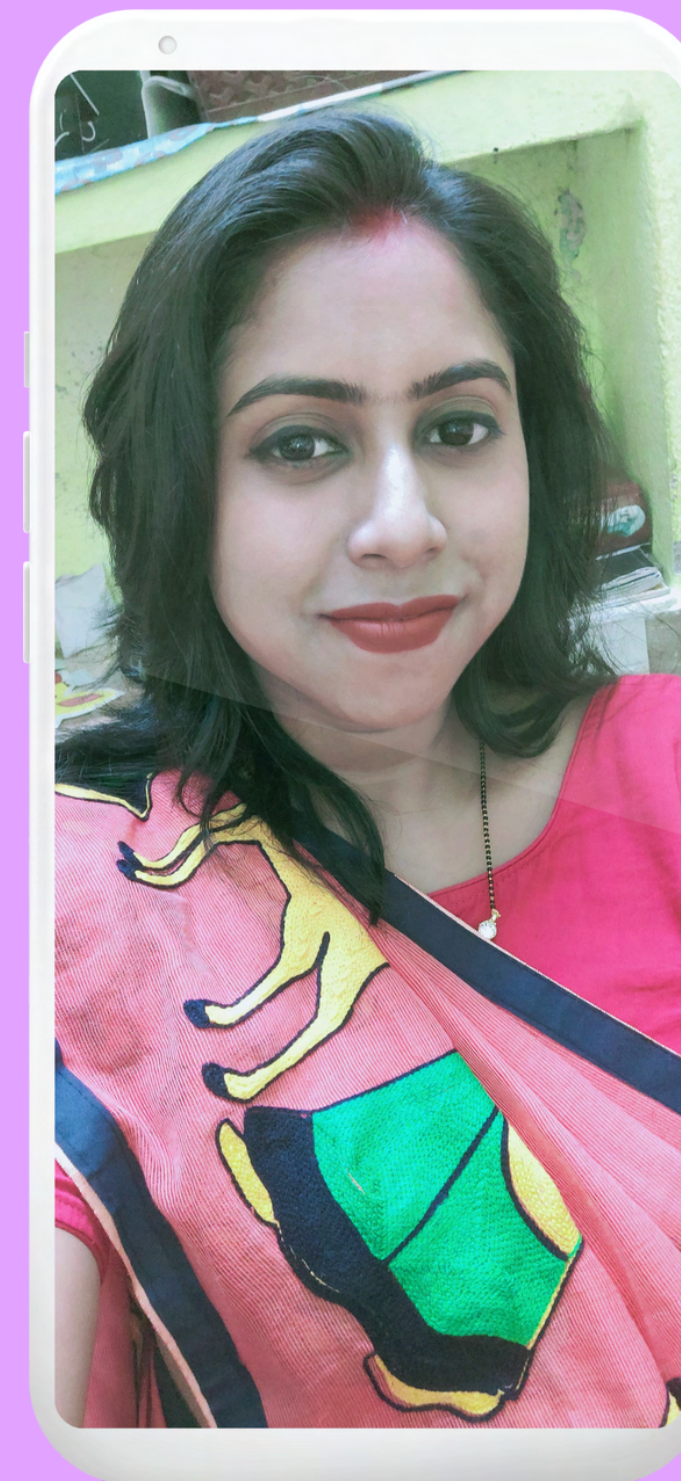
